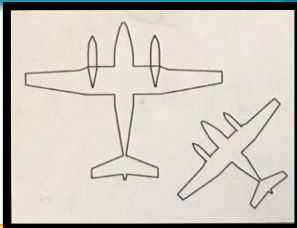


Many thanks to our friends Bill & Brenda Raymond for donating a very large Moose to the airport lobby's Up North Michigan decor! Stop in and see it!
