Otsego County is seeking bids for one (1) 2021 or 2022 Chevrolet Tahoe Police (PPV) CK10706 for its Sheriff's Office. All bids are to be based on the following minimum equipment standards:

Delivery Requirement:

Otsego County will take place as soon as possible after notification of bid award.

Vehicle Requirements:

- (1) One 2021 or 2022 Chevrolet Tahoe Police (PPV) CK 10706/ AZ3 4WD 4dr 40/20/40 Seating, 5T5 Front Cloth Seating / H1T JB cloth seat trim
- The color of the vehicle will be Black GBA

Tahoe Optional features:

- 6N6 – Door locks and handles, inside rear doors inoperative
- 5HP – Key, 6 additional keys
- 6E2 – Key common, complete vehicle fleet
- PCW – Enhanced Driver Alert Package
- AMF – Remote keyless entry package includes 6 additional transmitters. INCLUDES PROGRAMING.
- 6N5 – Switches, rear window inoperative
- UTQ – Theft deterrent system – DISABLE
- 6J3 – Wiring, grille lamps and siren speakers
- V76 – Recovery hooks, 2 front, frame mounted
- 7X7 – Spot lamps, left and right hand

These are all the factory direct requirements including additional features.
