Delivery Requirement:

Otsego County will take possession as soon as possible after notification of bid award.

Vehicle Requirements:

- (2) Two 2022 Chevrolet Tahoe Police (PPV) CK 10706/ AZ3 4WD 4dr 40/20/40 Seating, 5T5 Front Cloth Seating / H1T JB cloth seat trim
- The color of the vehicle will be Black GBA

Tahoe Optional features:

- 6N6 – Door locks and handles, inside rear doors inoperative
- 5HP – Key, 6 additional keys
- 6E2 – Key common, complete vehicle fleet
- PCW – Enhanced Driver Alert Package
- AMF – Remote keyless entry package includes 6 additional transmitters. INCLUDES PROGRAMING.
- 6N5 – Switches, rear window inoperative
- UTQ – Theft deterrent system – DISABLE
- 6J3 – Wiring, grille lamps and siren speakers
- V76 – Recovery hooks, 2 front, frame mounted
- 7X2 – Spot lamps, left and right hand
- 9C1 - PPV
